PRINCIPLES OF ADULT LEARNING & FACILITATION SKILLS

Effective adult education engages learners in three key ways:

- **Connecting with Content**: I-LED promotes interactive learning that allows participants to apply new concepts directly to their work.
- **Engaging with Facilitators**: Skilled facilitation enhances comprehension, fosters discussion, and creates a supportive learning environment.

 Peer-to-Peer Learning: Adults learn best from sharing experiences. I-LED encourages collaborative learning through discussion, role-playing, and real-world application. 03.
