A JAMA study found that 30-54 percent of female patients seeking emergency services, 21-66 percent of those seeking general medical care, and up to 20 percent of those seeking prenatal care report experiencing intimate partner violence. A health care provider can help reduce these staggering numbers by implementing <u>universal education guidelines</u> into their practice.
