This [Wednesday, October 8, 2025], [NAME OF FACILITY/SYSTEM/ASSOCIATION] is participating in Health Cares About Domestic Violence Day – an awareness-raising day that aims to reach members of the healthcare and advocacy communities to offer education about the critical importance of addressing the unique health needs of domestic violence survivors during public health emergencies and natural disasters.

Domestic violence can worsen in times of disaster or extra stress. Those experiencing domestic violence and are further isolated, and risk increased severity of violence when emergencies or disasters occur. For example, one study found domestic violence rates doubled during the pandemic.

At the same time, the needs of survivors of domestic violence have not been historically or routinely addressed in preparedness planning. In fact, some mitigation or support efforts focused on the disaster may inadvertently worsen situations for survivors.

It is crucial for healthcare providers to recognize the heightened risk of domestic violence, and partner with local survivor-serving programs when creating emergency preparedness plans.
